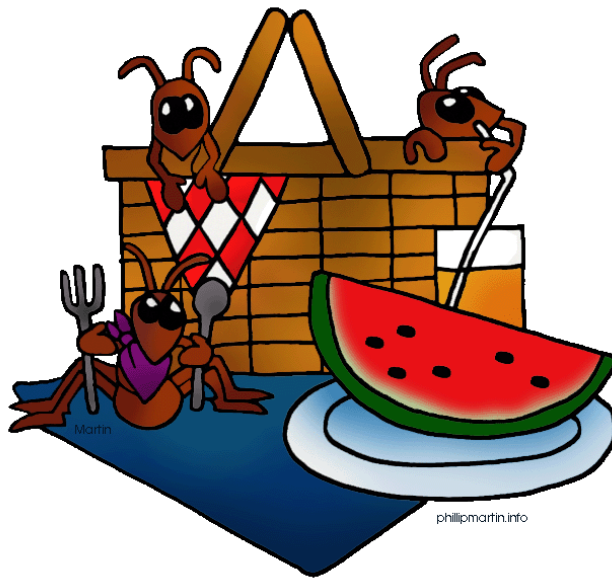

East Fairview joined Samaritan Counseling Center's "SafeChurch" program in June. We are clustered with four other local churches. The program provides guidelines for an updated Child Protection Policy, training for those who work with children, and education on topics such as: background checks, types of abuse, identifying perpetrators, and responding to victims of abuse. A core team from East Fairview comprised of Pastor Jimm Roland, Jessica Dunlevy, Ryan Dunlevy, Tina Kulp, Erin Martin and Mandi Stoltzfus, will receive in-depth training.
