**\*Nigeria today - an eyewitness account...**Growing up, he's heard countless stories about the Brethren in Nigeria, but, despite having traveled to many places around the world as a peacemaker, Cliff Kindy had never been to Nigeria. This spring he was sent there by Global Mission and Service. While there, he worked with the Nigerian Crisis Response team and wrote an account of what he witnessed.

**\*Canoes and ocean liners in Nigeria...**One group can't do it alone when it comes to providing assistance to those struggling to rebuild their lives in Nigeria. **\*Creating a climate for peace...**What does advocating for a stable climate have to do with promoting peace? In the final installment of their series on a faith-based response to climate change, Sharon Yohn and Laura White claim the two are more closely related than you may imagine.

## Favorite Recipes:

### Lemonade Angel Dessert

1 envelope unflavored gelatin	1/2 cup sugar	Dash salt
6oz. Can frozen lemonade concentrate	2 beaten eggs	1/2 cup water
(1) 14.5oz. Evaporated milk chilled & icy cold	Cool whip	(1) 10-inch tube angel cake

Mix gelatin, sugar & salt. Add eggs & water. Cook & stir til gelatin dissolves. Remove from heat. Stir in lemonade concentrate. Chill til partially set. Whip chilled evaporated milk til "peaks" form. Gently mix chilled gelatin mixture & whipped evaporated milk. Gently fold in angel food cake pieces and pour into 9x13 pan or decorative bowl. Chill. Frost with cool whip. Top with strawberry, blueberry or chopped nuts. Serves 12.

### Mexican Dressing from Aunt Mary

2/3 cup sugar	1/2 tsp pepper	1 tsp salt	1 medium onion—cut in pieces
1 cup veg. oil	1/3 cup dark vinegar	1 tsp celery seed	2-3 heaping tsp mustard

Blend everything well in blender. Store in fridge. 9 portions make 1 gallon. (Dressing was used over Pasta and on Mandarin Orange/Spinach Salads at Aunt Mary's 60<sup>th</sup> Anniv.)

### Chicken Zucchini from Eileen B. (Served at the Women's Banquet)

1/2 onion	1/2 cup margarine or butter	2 cups chicken - cooked & cut (used chicken breast)
2 Tbsp. milk	1 can cream of chicken soup	2.5 cups zucchini - chopped or shredded
1 egg	1 cup bisquick	1/4 cup grated parmesan cheese

Mix egg, bisquick and cheese to make into crumbs. Sauté onion & butter. Add zucchini & continue sautéing 5 minutes. Add soup thinned with milk. In 9x13 pan, layer chicken in serving size pieces. Spoon zucchini mix over chicken. Top with bisquick mixture. Bake @ 350 degrees for 40 minutes.
