## **A Letter from the Lancaster Church of the Brethren (Revised) EYN 2015 Visit to USA**

Planning Committee Requesting: 1) Prayers; 2) Housing; 3) Funds

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

Since 2004, a group of lay members from EYN (the Church of the Brethren in Nigeria) has been coming to the CoB in the US about every 2 years. The Brethren Evangelism Support Trust (BEST) group, a non-profit group that attended the 2013 Annual Conference, is planning a fraternal visit to the US CoB again this year from June 22 to July 18, 2015. This summer's BEST group will be much larger than previous groups. They have invited the EYN Women's Fellowship Choir (WFC) to join them for this visit. In the past we hosted around 25 or less. This year we are expecting as many as 50, depending on how many acquire their US visas. We are pleased that the WFC wants to join with BEST for this visit. The women will give concerts of praise and thanksgiving across at least 14 CoB Districts. The group will be singing several times at Annual Conference in Florida and look forward to sharing updates and stories from Nigeria. They will be giving 28 or more concerts and their travel through the Districts will exceed 4,000 miles.

The Lancaster Church of the Brethren (LCoB) is sponsoring and coordinating the EYN fraternal visit. The planning committee includes members from LCoB, Elizabethtown CoB, and Mountville CoB. The visitors will be in Atlantic Northeast District for 5 nights (July 3-7). **The committee needs 25-30 homes each night to accommodate the visitors.** As a planning committee, we are thankful for this opportunity that God has given us to share in Christian love and fellowship with our EYN brothers and sisters, especially during this time of suffering, challenge and need. We pray that their stay with us will be a time of blessing and encouragement, a time of love and understanding, and a time of joy and healing.

We invite your participation in several ways. First, please pray that the Holy Spirit may bless and guide the work of the planning committee as they prepare to receive the visitors on June 22. Pray too for the EYN brothers and sisters that they will have safe travel to the US. Secondly, the planning committee needs 25-30 Brethren homes each night to accommodate the visitors while they are in our district. If you have guest rooms that are available, please contact the church nearest you, **June 3 Elizabethtown CoB (717) 367-1000, June 4 & 7 Lancaster CoB (717) 397-4751 or July 5 & 6 Coventry CoB (610) 326-5426.** **Thirdly, we ask for your financial support to cover the cost of hosting the EYN visitors while they are here in the US. Each guest is responsible for their round trip air fare from Nigeria, but we estimate their cost in the US to be \$35-\$50 per person per day. The planning committee projects a need of about \$60,000 for this 2015 EYN visit. At the end of their stay, any money given in excess of expenses will go directly to the Nigeria Crisis Fund. Please send checks to the Lancaster CoB, 1601 Sunset Ave., Lancaster, PA 17601 with "EYN 2015 visit" on the memo line.**
