## Berry Barbecued Pork Roast

Submitted by Daphne Saks, taken from  
"Taste of Home Comfort food Cookbook Diet"

1 Boneless pork loin roast (3 lbs.)  
1/4 teaspoon salt & pepper  
4 cups fresh or frozen cranberries

1 cup sugar  
1/2 cup orange juice  
1/2 cup barbecue sauce

Sprinkle roast with salt and pepper. Place with fat side up on a rack in a shallow roasting pan. Bake, uncovered, at 350 degrees for 45 minutes. Meanwhile, in a saucepan, combine cranberries, sugar, orange juice and barbecue sauce. Bring to a boil. Reduce heat to medium-low; cook and stir for 10-12 minutes or until cranberries pop and sauce is thickened. Brush some of the sauce over roast. Bake 15-20 minutes longer or until meat thermometer reads 160 degrees, brushing often with the sauce. Let stand for 10 minutes before slicing. Serve with remaining sauce.
