Enjoy God's great outdoors with us September 19th-21st at Camp Swatara. Bring your RV, your tent, or rent a cabin for



#### COBYS 2014 Bike & Hike

After eclipsing the \$100,000 mark for the first time in 2013, we're back at it, planning for a bigger and better Bike & Hike in 2014. New this year is a silent auction.

The Bike & Hike is slated for Sunday, September 7th, at the Lititz Church of the Brethren, 300 W. Orange St., Lititz. Goals of 600 participants and \$110,000 have been set. Last year 538 participants raised more than \$104,000. Proceeds benefit COBYS ministries to children and families.

The Bike & Hike consists of a three-mile walk, 10- and 25-mile bicycle rides, and the 60-mile Dutch Country Motorcycle Ride. Participants choose their event, and then donate a registration fee, raise money from sponsors, or some of both. At the conclusion of the event, everyone gathers on the grounds at Lititz Church of the Brethren for refreshments, fellowship, and prizes, as we celebrate the outpouring of giving and thank participants and sponsors. Youth groups who raise \$1,500 or more earn a gym and pizza night.

We are continuing to add auction items for our first ever silent auction. A sampling of donations received so far includes a hand-painted vintage Harley-Davidson gas can; a night's stay at the elegant Hurst Family Bed & Breakfast; a Campbell Hausfeld one-gallon air compressor; a Lancaster Beverage Dispenser, mugs, and accessories; bicycle-theme gift basket; tickets to the Fulton Theater, Landis Valley Village & Farm Museum, Pennsylvania Renaissance Faire; and more. Merchandise, services, gift certificates, stays at vacation homes, and more are welcome!

Business sponsors have committed nearly \$20,000 so far. The Event Sponsor is <u>Cocalico Automotive, Inc.</u>, and <u>Hagy's Towing</u>. The <u>three-mile walk</u> travels through scenic Lititz Springs Park and on sidewalks through the streets of "America's Coolest Small Town."

The <u>10-mile bicycle ride</u> for kids and casual bikers is relatively flat, traveling through the country-side between Manheim and Lititz. Children age 12 and under must be accompanied by an adult.

The more challenging <u>25-mile route</u> includes some of Lancaster County's finest scenery and some moderate hills. A drink and fruit stop is provided.

This year's motorcycle ride travels north along some of Lancaster, Lebanon, and western Berks County's most scenic roads. Sights include the Middle Creek Wildlife Management Area, historic churches and meetinghouses, beautiful farmland, and more. Included is a break stop at Camp Swatara's Family Camping Area. (The route will be posted here, when finalized.) Support vehicles follow the bicycle and motorcycle routes.




