Favorite Recipes:

Fresh Summer Corn Salad

Ingredients:

- 5 ears of corn
- 1/2 cup diced red onion
- 1 cup cherry tomatoes, halved
- 1 orange pepper, diced
- 1/2 cup fresh basil leaves, chopped
- 1 scallion, chopped
- 2 small jalapenos, seeds removed,
chopped (I didn't add these)
- 2 Tbsp. cider vinegar
- 2 Tbsp. extra virgin olive oil
- 1/2 tsp salt
- 1/2 tsp pepper
- 1 Tbsp. lime juice

Instructions:

1. Place the corn in a pot of boiling salted water and cook for 3 minutes.
2. Drain and immerse in ice water.
3. Once cool, cut kernels off cob and place in serving bowl.
4. Add all other ingredients and enjoy or keep in fridge until ready to serve.
5. Makes 6 cups.

Greek Pasta Salad

Ingredients:

- 10 oz. vermicelli
- 3 Tbsp. lemon juice
- 1/4 cup corn oil
- 1/4 cup olive oil
- 1/4 cup mayonnaise
- 5 green onions, sliced
- 1 small can black olives
- 1 small jar pimentos, drained
- 2 Tbsp. Greek seasoning
- Garlic powder to taste
- Italian seasoning to taste
- Parmesan cheese to taste

Instructions:

1. Cook vermicelli according to directions and drain.
2. In a large mixing bowl, mix the vermicelli and the remaining ingredients.
3. Refrigerate overnight.

The program provides guidelines for an updated Child Protection Policy, training for those who work with children, and education on topics such as: background checks, types of abuse, identifying perpetrators, and responding to victims of abuse.
