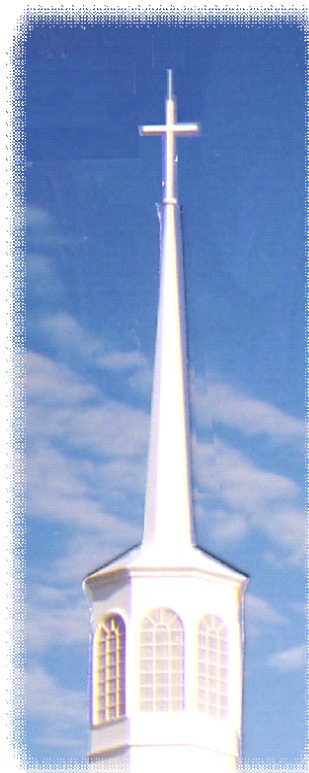

## UPDATED: Leadership Calling at Congregational Business Meeting (CBM)

At the next CBM on **Thursday, October 22<sup>nd</sup>**, the congregation will be calling leadership for multiple positions: **Leadership Team** (3 positions): Moderator (Barry Weidman), Stewardship (Mel Graybill), and Discipleship (Peg Thilo), and **Deacons** (2 positions). Mel and Peg are not eligible to be called for the Leadership Team positions as they have served their maximum terms. By-laws requires that leadership positions be posted 6 weeks prior to CBM - while the Team Leader positions met this requirement, the Deacon positions were inadvertently excluded and posted 3.5 weeks prior to CBM. **Please be in prayer over the next several weeks on who the Holy Spirit is calling to these important positions...including the possibility of it being you!**
