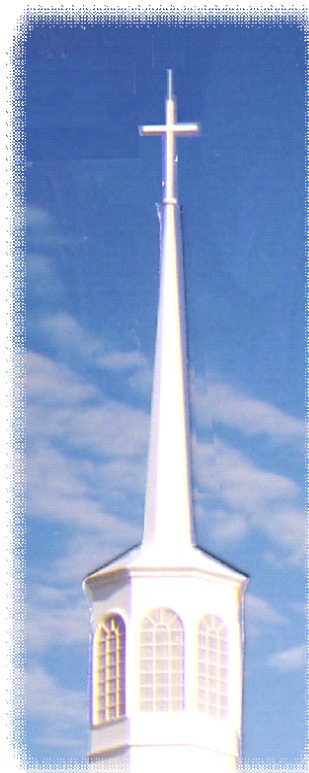

UPDATED: Leadership Calling at **Congregational Business Meeting (CBM)**

At the next CBM on **Thursday, October 22nd**, the congregation will be calling leadership for multiple positions: **Leadership Team** (3 positions): Moderator (Barry Weidman), Stewardship (Mel Graybill), and Discipleship (Peg Thilo), and **Deacons** (2 positions). Mel and Peg are not eligible to be called for the Leadership Team positions as they have served their maximum terms. By-laws requires that leadership positions be posted 6 weeks prior to CBM - while the Team Leader positions met this requirement, the Deacon positions were inadvertently excluded and posted 3.5 weeks prior to CBM. **Please be in prayer over the next several weeks on who the Holy Spirit is calling to these important positions...including the possibility of it being you!** Some believers know what the will of God in their life is, while others struggle to find it. After the call of salvation and following His example, there is still another calling - God's call to a specific ministry. The Lord has been calling individuals for specific ministries for millennia. Are you ready for God's call to a new ministry?
