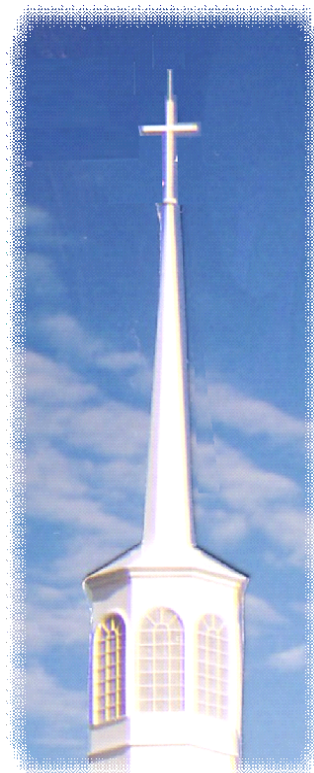

Disaster Relief Auction

September 25th & 26th at the Lebanon Fairgrounds

The Disaster Relief Auction publications are here. It has all the information you will need for the auction. Also, pie pans will be coming in early September for you to take and bake pies with. More information on that will be coming when they arrive.

Current/Ongoing Nigerian Relief Activities:

- *Thousands are receiving food, blankets, and household supplies
- *Land for Care Centers (IDP Camps) has been purchased and is being cleared for housing and farming
- *Trauma healing workshops are being held in many of the areas with displaced families
- *Thousands have been transported to safer areas
- *Temporary EYN Headquarters are furnished and occupied
- *Displaced church leadership have been provided rented homes
- *A special interfaith relocation project is building homes for 100 families (800 people). The project includes bore holes, community space, worship centers for both faiths and is located near farmland
- *A warehouse and two trucks have been purchased by EYN to support relief efforts
- *Advocacy with the US State Department and the US Embassy (Contributions to the Nigerian Crisis Fund can be made through our church. Please clearly designate your gift.)
