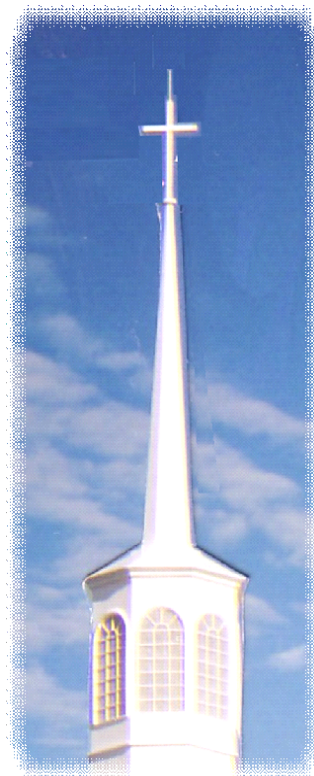

## **Current/Ongoing Nigerian Relief Activities:**

- \*Thousands are receiving food, blankets, and household supplies
- \*Land for Care Centers (IDP Camps) has been purchased and is being cleared for housing and farming
- \*Trauma healing workshops are being held in many of the areas with displaced families
- \*Thousands have been transported to safer areas
- \*Temporary EYN Headquarters are furnished and occupied
- \*Displaced church leadership have been provided rented homes
- \*A special interfaith relocation project is building home for 100 families (800 people). The project includes bore holes, community space, worship centers for both faiths and is located near farmland
- \*A warehouse and two trucks have been purchased by EYN to support relief efforts
- \*Advocacy with the US State Department and the US Embassy (Contributions to the Nigerian Crisis Fund can be made through our church. Please clearly designate your gift.)
