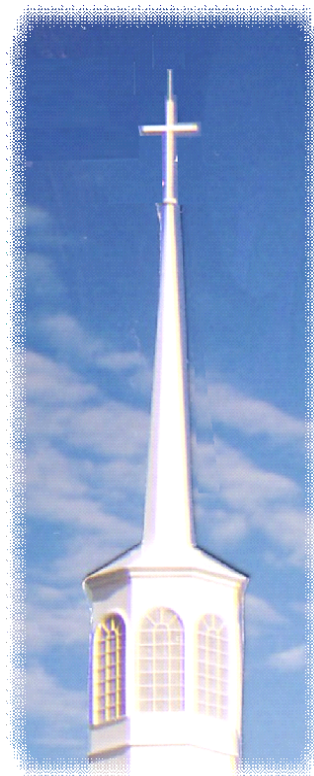

Every 4th week-end of September, members of the Church of the Brethren gather at the Lebanon County Fairgrounds for a two day effort to raise money for victims of natural and man-made disasters. This event is supported by the Atlantic Northeast & Southern Pennsylvania Districts, which represent more than 130 Brethren congregations. It has been unofficially stated that the Lebanon Disaster Relief Auction is the largest gathering of Brethren in the United States except for Annual Conference. While most people gather in the main auditorium, vendors representing broad areas of interest setup their booths to display crafts, foods items, literature, and educational materials.
